*Architectural Visualisation with Photoshop*

**FF** I studied building design and architecture at RMIT and developed good relationships with staff and students. These relationships inspire me and drew me back to the University. I am interested in this field as the built environment is based on a basic human need. Also I've been interested in the field history – why buildings or environments are as they are, the direction we're headed in and what we're losing in the process.

The course covers advanced Photoshop techniques for creating interior and exterior architectural visualisations. It's about taking rendered images from modelling software and doing the post-editing to make the images (or concept) really sing. This short course will support and strengthen software skills used in architecture, building design, urban and landscape design or interior design and decoration – basically any program concerned with the built environment.

Skills learnt in the course will strengthen employment prospects for anyone entering the architecture and design industry for external or internal built environment.

With stop motion animation, you can bring objects to life. Even though everything in front of the camera is completely real, you can make surprising and impossible things happen.

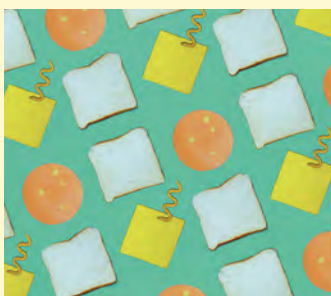
I'm driven by curiosity and observation — I take inspiration from my surroundings and from contemporary art and design.

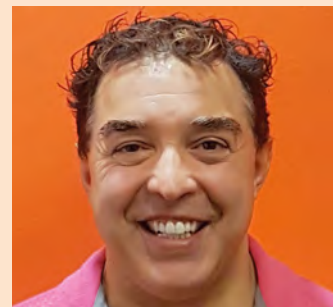

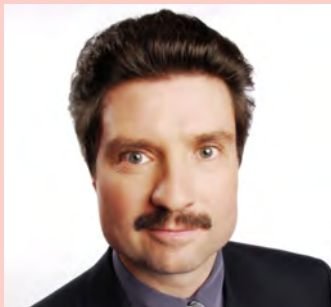
